INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS

1. The bidder should quote rate after careful study of bid document.
2. The rates should be quoted both in figures as well as in words. Similarly, the total amount of the individual items should also be mentioned both in figures as well as in words.
3. The bid must accompany NTN certificate from concerned Income Tax Office without which the bid will not be entertained.
4. Any rebate on tendered rates of item/whole bid cost shall not be accepted.
5. Bid will be valid for the 120 days.
6. No tender will be received telegraphically or by post.
7. Conditional tender will not be accepted.
8. The bidder must provide PRA Certificate along with bid.
9. In case the total tendered amount is less than **5% (Five)** of the approved estimated (DNIT) amount, the lowest bidder will have to deposit additional performance security from the Scheduled Bank ranging from **5.01% to 10%**.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

The conditions provided in this section of bidding documents shall prevail upon General Directions for Guidance of Tenderer and General Conditions of Contract.

1. The Contractor shall attach relevant documents as a support which is required in technical evaluation criteria duly signed and stamped by bidder otherwise bids shall not be qualified.
2. The decision of Technical Evaluation committee shall be final and acceptable by the bidders.
3. The successful bidder shall have to submit water testing report quarterly basis both sides from inlet and outlet.
4. The Contractor shall maintain the Plant and the portions of the Works, which are on the standby mode, in a manner that they remain protected and functional.
5. The successful bidder shall have to arrange pre-shipment inspection at manufacturer's site of work by a firm of international repute regarding their correctness and genuineness in respect of specification mentioned in the bid Schedule. The certificate so issued be provided at the time of delivery at site failing which material will not be accepted.
6. The operation and maintenance of water filtrations plants shall include, but may not be limited to, the following functions and activities;
 - a) Operation of the Plants and the Equipment.
 - b) Repaint of plant house and Replacement of all defective parts with original principle parts as already installed, immediately after taking over from agency and at the time of handing over to agency.
 - c) Dosing of process control chemicals, if required
 - d) All the process and Plant control measures and activities
 - e) All the process and Plant relates troubleshooting
 - f) Disposal of rejected water as per the guidelines of Environmental Protection Agency of Pakistan and **WHO** Guidelines,
7. Firm shall be responsible to ensure the display of all SCADA operated plants with already integrated parameters in WASA Office otherwise penalty **@Rs.50.00** per hour / plant will be imposed and firm shall ensure the availability of well-disciplined and well conversant SCADA operator at least 9 hour/ day in WASA office.
8. Develop android / smartphone app including SCADA access by providing 3 smartphones along with login access to WASA officers and firm shall be responsible to share the progress reporting supported with pictures and daily water consumption of all plants with geo-location / geotagging of each plant highlighting the condition of the plant with proper functionality.
9. Proper handing over of filtration plants equipped with SCADA System shall be made from WASA to successful contractor upon award of contract.
10. Successful firms / contractors shall be responsible to hand over the complete SCADA system to WASA / succeeding contractor / firm in functional condition in all respects after expiry of contract.
11. Firm shall be responsible to ensure surrounding area and environmental goods hygienic condition (cleanliness of plants houses, machinery and dispensing area). Eradication of epidemic (dengue etc) and making arrangements for

- prevention of water stagnation etc. Otherwise the firm will be account for all kind of legitimations / litigations.
12. The successful bidder shall have to ensure the availability of necessary and adequate spare parts / machineries of each capacity on standby mode, for forthwith rectifications of complaints.
 13. The contractor shall employ its best efforts to minimize nuisance for the surrounding areas as per guidelines of EPA.
 14. The successful bidder shall be responsible for safety and security of plants any theft or damage shall be recovered in his own risk and cost.
 15. Any complaint received from public / WASA Staff regarding efficiency / operation shall be resolved by the firm within (03-hours for minor and 24 hours for major issues) otherwise penalty @**Rs.3,000.00** per hour will be imposed.
 16. Surprise visits at filtration plants sites may be conducted by WASA, any negligence or shortcoming (may not be limited to Cleanliness & maintenance of plant house, machinery, dispensing area, water taps / valves, Tiles etc) shall result in imposition of fine / penalty @ **Rs.2000** per site / day.
 17. During public holidays the firms shall attend complaints without any delay otherwise clause **No.14&15** shall be invoked.
 18. WASA shall carry out the sudden checking / visit to check the complaint monitoring center and its working / performance.
 19. Firm shall be responsible for attendance / resolution of all complains for **03 months** beyond handing / taking over without any additional cost to bind the firm.
 20. The successful bidder shall maintain and share proper record concerning time of complaint received and redressal time with issue of rectifications.
 21. Log book will be maintained by the operator / supervisor.
 22. The successful bidder shall have to submit water testing report from laboratory duly approved / recommended by WASA Chemist / as per satisfaction / approval of engineer in charge at both ends i.e inlet and outlet.
 23. Firm shall ensure in time submission of original water quality test reports and samples will be collected in presence of firm's and laboratory's representative, in accordance with the vetted / approved schedule by the concerned WASA officer.
 24. Installation shall be in well maintained condition at the time of handing / taking over to agency after successful completion of contract and it will be ensured through joint inspection of client / firm representatives.
 25. The Contractor shall ensure by his own means and guarantee that the product water in every respect shall be in accordance with the **WHO** guidelines. The composition of the feed water, in terms of its constituents and their variations, of whatsoever nature, shall not prevent him from achieving the desired performance results.
 26. In case any deficiency found in quality of product water in the water test reports submitted shall be solely responsibility of the firm and its rectification including replacement of filter media.
 27. The successful bidder shall have to submit performance security @**5%** of contract amount which shall be released after **03-Months** beyond the successful completion of contract.

28. **MODE OF PAYMENT**

A. **Payment relates to replacement of filter media**

70% of filter media payment will be made on delivery of filter media on site and 20% payment will be made on replacement of filter media and 10% of gross amount of work done shall be retained by WASA as retention money which shall be released after expiry of warranty period i.e **03-years**.

B. **Payment relates to O&M**

The successful bidder shall have to submit invoices for payment quarterly basis along with water testing reports. 90% payment of each invoice shall be made and 10% of Gross amount of each invoice shall be retained by WASA as a retention money which shall be released after **06-months** of successful completion of services.

29. Proper Handing over / Taking over of filtration plants shall be made on expiry of contract period to WASA concerned quarter after checking the physical condition of filtration plants.
30. Commencement of O&M of Filtration Plants shall be started from award of work / issuance of letter of acceptance and duration of O&M shall be **01-year**.
31. Commencement of Replacement of Filter media shall be started from date of award of contract / issuance of letter of acceptance and shall be completed within **90-days** of issuance of acceptance letter.
32. The successful bidder shall have to establish computerized emergency complaint cell / service center for receiving of complaint round the clock **24/7** rather public or WASA for prompt rectification / attendance of complaints within a week of the issuance of acceptance letter.
33. During public holidays the Firm shall Attend complaints without any delay otherwise clause **No.15** shall be invoked.
34. The bid security in the shape of **CDR** amounting to **Rs.2,910,747.00** shall be submitted with technical bid failing which the bid may be rejected.
35. Experience as sub-contractor shall not be considered to meet the evaluation criteria.
36. Subletting of work shall not be allowed.
37. The successful bidder shall have provide (***E-Stamp Paper according to stamp act article No.22-A(a)(v)***) for execution of contract agreement within **15-days** of issuance letter of Acceptance
38. **Joint Venture** must comply with the following requirements: -
 - a) Following are minimum requirements for Joint Venture: -
 - i) In accordance with PEC Bye Laws, Foreign Firms are required to form JVs with local Firms.
 - ii) The lead partner shall meet not less than **40%** percent of all qualifying criteria given in paras heretofore.
 - iii) Subject to clause **38a(ii)** the joint venture must collectively satisfy the technical evaluation criteria. Heretofore, for which purpose the relevant figures for each of the partners shall be added together to arrive at the JV's total capacity. Individual members must satisfy each of the requirements
 - iv) The lead partner shares shall not be less than **51%**.
 - v) JV shall not be comprising more than 03 members.

vi) The bidder shall provide intended JV agreement at the time of bidding and shall provide the JV agreement must registered with sub registrar mentioning the joint and several liabilities with respect to the contract and Joint account of the firms to whom the transactions shall be made at the time of execution of contract agreement. In case of failure to provide register JV agreement at the time of contract agreement the securities submitted by the bidder shall be forfeited.

b) Any change in a technically responsive/ qualified JV after evaluation, shall be subject to the written approval of the client such approval may be denied if: -

i) Partner(s) withdraw from a JV and remaining partners do not meet the qualifying / technical evaluation criteria;

ii) The new partners to a JV are not stand qualified/ responsive individually or as another JV; or

iii) In the opinion of the Client, a substantial reduction in competition would result.

iv) One firm shall not be partner in more than one JV.

c) Bid shall be signed by all members in the JV so as to legally bind all partners, jointly and severally, and any bid shall be submitted with a copy of the JV agreement dully registered with sub-registrar providing the joint and several liabilities with respect to the contract.

39. The technically evaluation of a JV does not necessarily qualify any of its partners individually or as a partner in any other JV or association. In case of dissolution of a JV, each one of the constituent firms may be declared qualified / technically responsive if they meet all the requirements as described in technical criteria and any partner of JV has requested/shall request for the same and then his qualification shall be subject to the written approval of the Client.

40. The Bidder (including all members of a JV) must not be associated, nor have been associated in the past, with the consultants or any other entity that has prepared the design, specifications and bidding documents for the project, or was proposed as Engineer for the contract, over the last **five (05) years**. Any such association may result in disqualification/ non-responsiveness of the Bidder.

41. A qualified firm/contractor/JV may participate only in one bid only for the contract. If a firm submits more than one bid, singly or as a JV, all bids including that bidder will be rejected.

42. In case of foreign constructor or foreign operator wishing to perform any construction or operation of engineering works in Pakistan shall obtain an appropriate licence from the Council before initiating any activity which is a subject of these Bye-laws. The foreign constructor or foreign operator may be granted licence only for specific projects which need capacity, expertise and specialized technology of construction or operation to optimize cost and time not available with a Pakistani constructor or Pakistani operator. Any such foreign constructor or foreign operator shall enter into a joint venture agreement with the Pakistani constructor or Pakistani operator in which share of foreign constructor or foreign operator shall be limited to the expertise and technology not available with the Pakistani constructor or Pakistani operator. The establishment of a joint venture shall be subject to the condition that share of the Pakistani constructor or Pakistani operator shall not be less than thirty percent.

TECHNICAL EVALUATION CRITERIA

PART-A BASIC ELIGIBILITY

1. Authorization from Original Equipment Manufacturer (**OEM**).
2. The manufacturer should be **NSF** approved.
3. Registration certificate / Memorandum of Association / Article of Association /Partnership deed registered with sub-registrar/ Affidavit of sole proprietorship.
4. Registration with **FBR & PRA** (NTN & PNTN).
5. The bidder shall have valid registration with **PEC** as Category **C-4** or above with specialization in code **ME-06**.
6. Experience of similar nature i.e installation or O&M of filtration plants including SCADA system or separate experience of SCADA system of any worth (***sum of scope of work shall not be less than "installation of 50 No. water filtration plants" or "50 No. O&M of filtration plants"***) in last **15 years** with Government Departments/Semi Government/ Public and Private Sector.
7. Average annual turnover of **Rs.145 Million** in last **03**-years.
8. Liquid assets of **Rs.50 Million**. The firm shall provide authenticated bank balance sheet issued not before 30-days of submission of bids or valid credit line limit.
9. Personal Capabilities having **01 No.** chemical and **01 No.** mechanical engineers.
10. Audited financial reports of last three (**03**) **years** from reputed chartered accountant firm.
11. No Black Listing certificate on stamp paper of **Rs.100**.
12. Litigation history if any, of the previous 05-years in which the Bidder was either directly or substantially indirectly involved in. The bidder shall provide accurate information on the prescribed Performa (**Annex-A**) about any litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts completed or ongoing under its execution over the last 05-year. A consistent history of court / arbitral award against the bidder or any member of J.V may result in disqualifying bidder. This requirement also applies to contract executed by the bidder as J.V member. All pending litigation shall in total not represent more than Forty percent (40%) of the Applicant's net worth and shall be treated as resolved against the Applicant the each member of J.V shall meet this requirement otherwise whole J.V shall be considered as non-responsive or otherwise provide no litigation certificate on stamp paper of **Rs.100**.

Note :

The technical evaluation shall be on **knockout** basis both in part A (Basic Eligibility) & B (Technical Requirements). In case bidder fails to meet any of the requirement in **Part A, Basic Eligibility**, shall not be considered for further evaluation.
